

**ORDINANCE 2015-005**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SPECIAL PURPOSE FLOOD DAMAGE REDUCTION PROCEDURES ORDINANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Village Council, by prior Ordinance 2008-016 established special purpose flood damage reduction procedures; and

**WHEREAS**, certain changes are necessary to update Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM) and Flood Insurance Study (FIS) and penalties.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER, SHELBY COUNTY, AND STATE OF OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.**

That in Section 1.6 of the previous Ordinance entitled "Basis for Establishing the Areas of Special Flood Hazard"; that sub-sections A. and B. read as follows:

- A. Flood Insurance Rate Map and Flood Insurance Study for Shelby County, Ohio and Incorporated areas both effective April 2, 2015.
- B. Other studies and / or maps, which may be relied upon for establishment of the flood protection elevation, delineation of the 100-year floodplain, floodways or delineation of other areas of special flood hazard.

**SECTION 2.**

That in Section 6.3 of the previous Ordinance entitled "Violations and Penalties"; that the language is amended to read:

Violation of the provisions of these regulations or failure to comply with any of its requirements shall be deemed to be a strict liability offense, and shall constitute a 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Misdemeanor. Any person who violates these regulations or fails to comply with any of its requirements shall upon conviction thereof be fined or imprisoned as provided by the laws of the State of Ohio, in accordance with ORC 2929.28 or ORC 2929.31, or as they may be amended. Each day such violation continues, shall be considered a separate offense. Nothing herein contained shall prevent the Village of Jackson Center from taking such other lawful action as it necessary to prevent or remedy any violation. The Village of Jackson Center shall prosecute any violation of these regulations in accordance with the penalties stated herein.


**SECTION 3.**

Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare; such an emergency arising out of the need to consistently administer the special purpose flood damage reduction procedures and to make updates when needed. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.


