

**RESOLUTION 2015-001**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO DISPOSE OF CERTAIN PROPERTY DECLARED AS SURPLUS THROUGH INTERNET AUCTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Jackson Center from time to time has certain property, fleet and equipment assets that have reached the limit of useful life; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that the Village of Jackson Center has certain property, fleet and equipment assets that are not needed for municipal purposes and/or are obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired; and

**WHEREAS**, disposal of these assets through auction maximizes the Village of Jackson Center's return on investment in such personal property, fleet and equipment assets; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that internet auction is a method through which the Village of Jackson Center may wish to dispose of these assets; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Jackson Center has chosen GovDeals as the vendor to implement an internet auction;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER, STATE OF OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.**

The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to dispose of personal property, fleet and equipment assets that have been declared as surplus through the use of internet auction. Notice of said auction to the highest bidder will be published at least twice in a newspaper of general circulation, including description as to how the auction(s) will be conducted, the general items and conditions of the sale, and the specific number of days for bidding on the property, which shall be no less than ten (10) calendar days, including Saturdays, and Sundays and legal holidays.

**SECTION 2.**

This auction will be conducted using a third-party contractor, namely:

That Council hereby declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare; such an emergency arising out of the need to dispose of obsolete personal property as efficiently and effectively as possible. Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.
