Jackson Center Schools Traffic Flow and Parking Plan

Please note the following as we adjust to the new school facilities and lots:
Door Numbers 1, 2 and 16 are the MAIN Entry Doors.

Students being dropped off by parents will enter through Door 1 (Central West Side entrance)

Students being dropped off by the bus will enter through Door 16 (East Side)

High School students that are parking in the Student Parking Lot will enter through Door 2 (the previous main entrance on the West side)

Parents that are dropping off students will follow the blue traffic pattern and enter on South Street off of Main Street (SR 65). They will follow the ONE WAY traffic pattern onto Linden and enter the Staff and Visitor Parking Lot and continuing to follow alongside the sidewalk. Please pull as far forward as possible to avoid causing congestion.

Do NOT use the Davis Street entrance to drop students off. This entrance is ONLY for those parking in that lot.

Do NOT use the Student parking lot on the West Side of the school to drop students off. Please also note that the opening to the West Parking Lot from SR 65 is an EXIT ONLY.
