

ORDINANCE 2016-028

AN ORDINANCE TO SET THE RATES AND CHARGES FOR REFUSE REMOVAL SERVICES FOR THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village contracts for the removal of solid waste from the Village; and

WHEREAS, the costs to remove said waste has increased; and

WHEREAS, Council deems it necessary to adjust the rates and charges for the removal of solid waste; and

WHEREAS, the charges for the trash bags sold by the Village include the cost of the solid waste contract with Republic Services, the cost of actual bags, the cost of disposal of tag items and the cost of maintenance of the vending machine; and

WHEREAS, the Council will offer another option for the removal of solid waste with a 96 gallon tote. Residents will be able to rent the tote from Republic Services. This service comes with an unlimited clause in which large items may be set out with the tote and picked up with no additional charge; and

WHEREAS, the rates and charges for the solid waste removal are being established for the years of 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021, subject to any subsequent action Village council may enact.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER, SHELBY COUNTY, AND OHIO.

SECTION 1.

The rate to purchase 30 gallon capacity bags provided by the Village and sold in bundles of ten (10) for disposal of solid waste are as follows:

2017	25.00	February 1, 2017
2018	25.00	February 1, 2018
2019	26.00	February 1, 2019
2020	26.00	February 1, 2020
2021	27.00	February 1, 2021

No 50-55 gallon drums, items containing Freon, auto batteries or other hazardous materials are permitted.

SECTION 2.

Bulk Items that will not fit in the 30 gallon capacity bags provided by the Village can be disposed of by purchasing tags. All items are suggestive and it is further understood that the unlisted items will be classed per equivalent volume and weight and priced accordingly.

Small Tag – television, unstuffed chair, sink, screens and storm windows, play-pen, bicycle, lawn mower (liquids removed), crates, small tables, lamps, and most everything else that weights less than 20 pounds and would fit into a 3' x 3' x 3' square.	\$4.00
Large Tag – bathtub, toilet, couch, stuffed chair, table, cabinet, shelves, bed frame, mattress, box spring, and most any single item that weights under 70 pounds and can be safely managed by one	\$10.00

Appliance Tag – washers, dryers, stove, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, and hot water heaters (drained) pressure tanks (drained). Items that once contained CFC's must have a certification tag that the refrigerant has been removed by a licensed technician.	\$10.00

SECTION 3.

The rate to rent a 96 gallon capacity tote provided by Republic Services for disposal of solid waste are as follows:

2020	13.68	February 1, 2020
2021	14.10	February 1, 2021

SECTION 4.


