- ◆ These vehicles shall only be operated on streets that have a speed limit of 35 mph or less. (This includes Pike Street (SR 274), However you cannot travel east of Parkview Drive or west of Dr. Trygstad's Office). Main Street (SR 65) nothing further north than Jerry Drive and nothing south of the new park entrance.
- ◆ Vehicles shall have the following functioning equipment:
 - Headlights
 - Taillights
 - Brake Lights
 - Turn Signals
 - Horn
 - Review Mirror
 - Windshield
 - Adequate Braking Ability
- ◆ These vehicles shall only be operated by persons that possess a Valid Driver's License

FALL SEASONAL SAFETY TIPS

Autumn brings one of the most beautiful times of the year with colorful leaves and pumpkins littering the ground. The season also brings up safety issues. Prepare for the changing weather of the fall to ensure a happy and healthy season!

As autumn comes into full swing, the temperatures may lower in your area, which can lead to several safety issues.

In Your Home:

Have your chimney and furnace cleaned and inspected on a regular basis. This helps prevent chimney fires and carbon monoxide buildup.

Keep your fireplace hearth free of newspapers, magazines, toys, or anything combustible.

Do not burn cardboard boxes of trash in your fireplace, as they can cause chimney fires.

Be sure the house is well ventilated when painting or using other chemicals.

Leave at least three feet of space around your space heater. Remember to unplug it when it's not in use.



LEAF COLLECTION

The Village will begin their annual leaf collection program in October. This is a free service for Jackson Center residents. Leaf pick-up on the south side of SR 274 will occur on Mondays and pick up on the north side of SR 274 will occur on Tuesdays. Leaves should be placed next to the curb, not in the street. Leaf piles must be free of twigs, sticks, branches, bags, etc.
